Both Ayush Kumar of Rajendra Vidyalaya and Aishwarya San of Carmel Junior College got 99.5% each. They are science students and both hail from Steel City.

For ISC, the marks secured in English and the best of three subjects are taken into consideration.

As many 13 students of St. Xavier's School, Doranda in Ranchi scored 90% and above and Ayush Stephen Toppo secured 98% and emerged as the school topper. Raj Vaibhav came second with 97.25%.

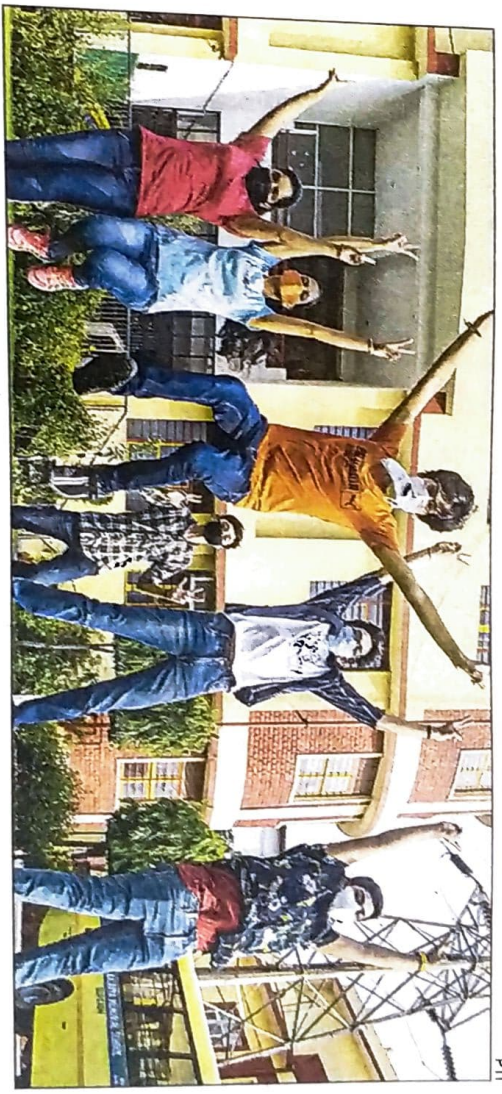
